Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Government Autonomous College, Rourkela has the mandate to design and collect feedback from its stakeholders to monitor and evaluate its quality on curriculum and curriculum-related issues. The feedback was collected from teachers on several aspects of the curriculum and its learning-related issues in terms of quality, competence, skills and professionalism. The faculty members submitted the feedback to IQAC, Government Autonomous College, Rourkela and then IQAC analyzed the report for taking necessary measures and actions as to comply with the issue raised by the different stake holders.

The teachers feedback was collected from teachers with the help of Google form. The responses are scored over a five-point scale (Strongly agree, Agree, neutral, Disagree, strongly disagree) which reflected the viewpoints of faculty members from the different departments. IQAC taken the suggestions and discuss with authorities and accordingly authorities given the instructions to the departments for better quality improvement in the curriculum design and teaching learning process.

The feedback contained following questions to measure the satisfaction level of faculty member about overall performance of the institution. The feedback forms of teachers regarding the teaching learning process are collected through online mode


Feedback Analysis and Interpretation of Salient Findings

- 1. It has been observed that 94.44% of faculty members Strongly agreed with the resources availability for curriculum delivery and 5.56% of faculty members agreed that resources are aptly available.
- **2.** It has been noticed that a 100% of teachers agreed with the Online teaching Process supported by the Institution.
- 3. It was found that 100% faculty members agreed with the Online evaluation Process supported by Government Autonomous College, Rourkela
- 4. It has been observed that 96.30% of faculty members Strongly agreed with the Initiative taken by the college for encouraging to organize and participate in online webinar /Indication or Refresher courses, whereas 1.85% teachers are agree and 1.85% are neutral in this matter.
- **5.** It has been observed that 100% of faculty members Strongly agreed with the Initiative and preventive measures taken by the college during covid-19 pandemic.
- **6.** It has been observed that 75.93% of faculty members Strongly agreed with the curriculum design is contemporary and focuses on employability whereas 22.22% faculty members are agree with this and 1.85% are neutral about it.
- 7. It was found that 70.37% faculty members Strongly agreed, 24.07 are agreed and 5.56% are neutral that at Government Autonomous College, Rourkela has sufficient numbers of reading materials and resources are available in the College Library.

- **8.** It was observed that 66.67% faculty members Strongly agreed, whereas 31.48% are agreed and 1.85% are neutral about the supportiveness of college staff, management and other stakeholders.
- 9. It has been observed that 59.26% of faculty members are strongly agreed with the ICT infrastructure of college, whereas 37.04% are agreed and 3.70% of faculty members are neutral with the ICT infrastructure of the college.
- **10.** It was found that 64.81% faculty members Strongly agreed, whereas 33.33% are agreed and 1.85% are neutral that at Government Autonomous College, Rourkela has Well maintained and updated College Website.
- 11. It was found that 74.07% of faculty members are strongly agreed that the college has taken initiatives to encourage research, whereas 25.93% of faculty members are neutral in this matter.
- 12. It has been found that 66.67% of faculty members are strongly agreed that the institution has adequate, clean and well maintained classrooms and furniture, whereas 31.48% are agreed and 1.855 are neutral that the institute has adequate number of this facility.
- **13.** It was found that 53.70% of faculty members are strongly agreed that the labs are adequately equipped for hand-on training of students whereas 42.59% of faculty members are agree and 3.70% neutral with the lab facility.
- **14.** It has been noticed that 61.11% of faculty members are strongly agreed that the college has an effective grievance redressal system whereas 33.33% of faculty members are agreed and 5.56% that the college has an effective redressal system.
- **15.** It is observed that all the faculty members are highly satisfied on the various college activities thus they encourage students to pursue their education in this college.


































