Guidelines for Internal Stream Change within HSS

Students admitted to Class-XI for the 2024-25 academic session through the SAMS portal of DHSE (O) may change their stream within the same Higher Secondary School, following the guidelines.

- Interested students may submit a plain paper application to the Principal of the HSS to request a stream change between 11:00 AM on 09.12.2024 and 6:00 PM on 14.12.2024, subject to seat availability in the desired stream.
- If the number of applicants exceeds the available seats, the HSS will prepare a merit list based on the marks secured by each student.
- No reservations or weightage will be considered in the preparation of the merit list.
- 4. The total marks secured by the student must meet or exceed the cut-off marks for the stream into which they wish to transfer.
- The process of stream transfer, along with the admission update in the SAMS portal (e-Space), must be completed by 6:00 PM on 18.12.2024.
- No increase in seats will be considered if the number of applicants for a stream change exceeds the available vacant seats in the respective stream at the HSS.

Transfer Admission Guideline (Class-XI)

The transfer admission process for Class XI (1st Year) students will be conducted online at www.samsodisha.gov.in. Interested students can apply for transfer admission to another Higher Secondary School, either within the same stream or a different one, by following the specified guidelines. Class XI students in the state's Higher Secondary Schools must log in to the SAMS portal using their existing student user ID (mobile number) and the password provided during their online registration and admission.

1. Procedure for Online Transfer

1.1. Application Process

Eligible students can apply for transfer by using the application form available in the student's e-Space login. The steps for the online transfer process are outlined below.

Selection Criteria

- ✓ The student can select their preferred Higher Secondary School for transfer admission as outlined below.
 - a) Selection is based on seat availability and requires meeting or exceeding the cut-off marks for the desired stream. Note that seat numbers will not be increased.
- ✓ The leaving Higher Secondary School will verify the student's information, including name, roll number, stream, and subject, and provide remarks accordingly.
- ✓ The Nodal Higher Secondary School (SAMS) will verify the supporting documents attached by the student and provide remarks regarding their authenticity on the application.
- ✓ After verifying the application details, the Director of Higher Secondary Education, Odisha, will take appropriate action and issue the order accordingly.



- ✓ The applications approved by the Director of Higher Secondary Education, Odisha, will appear in the destination Higher Secondary School for updating the required information to complete the transfer admission.
- Transfer admission approval by DHSE (O) for vacancies in Higher Secondary Schools will be considered on a merit basis.
- ✓ For students applying for a transfer to another stream in a different Higher Secondary School, their general marks secured in the 10th board exam must meet the cut-off percentage specified for the 1st, 2nd, or 3rd phase of the e-Admission academic session 2024-25.
- ✓ Approval from DHSE (O) does not guarantee admission to the destination Higher Secondary School, as it is purely provisional. The student must obtain the HSSLC from the leaving Higher Secondary School and report to the destination Higher Secondary School within the specified timeline.
- ✓ Higher Secondary Schools are advised to issue the HSSLC only after the DHSE (O) has issued the candidate's transfer order.
- ✓ A candidate who has willingly obtained the HSSLC without the DHSE (O) transfer order approval will not be eligible for transfer admission.
- ✓ Higher Secondary Schools are required to collect, verify, and store the transfer order issued by DHSE (O) and submit it to CHSE (O) during the Class XI annual examination form fill-up.
- ✓ Applicants can check the status of their applications in their respective e-Space logins.
- ✓ Transfer admissions are not permitted for students from boards or councils
 other than the CHSE (O) Board.
- Students must be admitted through the Common Application Form (CAF) during the regular e-Admission period, in accordance with the schedule published for the respective admission year.
- Transfer cases from outside the state may be considered only in the event of the transfer, retirement, or death of a parent, provided that the syllabus aligns with the CHSE (O) syllabus and has received due approval from DHSE (O).
