In pursuance of the directive from the Department of Higher Education (DHE), Govt. of Odisha (Letter No. HE-NSS-MISC-0002-2024-30119/HE, dated 06.06.2026), our institution is executing a special Mission Mode Campaign to achieve 100% registration of remaining students on the MY Bharat (Mera Yuva Bharat) Portal.

While a section of students has already completed registration during previous phases, all Heads of Departments (HODs), Faculty Mentors, and Coordinators are hereby instructed to actively sensitize UG and PG students and organize departmental awareness drives/classroom registration sessions immediately.

Key Action Points for Departments & Wings:

1. Departmental Sensitization & Registration:

- HODs and Faculty Mentors are requested to inform students in all classes about the benefits of the platform (experiential learning, volunteering, leadership development, and nation-building initiatives) and ensure that un-registered students complete their profile setup.

2. Portal Link:

- Students can register directly at <https://mybharat.gov.in> using their mobile number/Aadhaar/email.

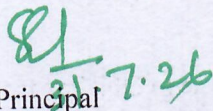
3. Volunteer Guidelines:

- During registration on the MY Bharat portal, students can register under the **Youth** category in one of the following sub-categories: **YRC, NSS, NCC, or MY Bharat**.
- Students wishing to register under **NCC** must contact the **NCC Officer-in-Charge** first prior to registration.
- For volunteering under **YRC** or **NSS**, students should consult the respective **YRC and NSS Officers-in-Charge**.
- Note for Students:** Active volunteering in NCC, NSS, or YRC can be highly beneficial for fulfilling community engagement work requirements in your academic program.

4. Progress Reporting & Monitoring:

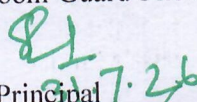
- Each department must maintain a record of registered students and submit a weekly status update to the designated MY Bharat Nodal Officer.
- Photos/records of awareness sessions held in classrooms or units should be documented for submission in the institution-level progress report to DHE.
