

To prevent ragging. UGC has framed regulations on curbing the menace of ragging in higher educational institutions. These regulations are mandatory, and all institutions are required to take necessary steps for its implementation in toto including the monitoring mechanism as per provisions in the above regulations and ensure its strict compliance. The UGC has also taken several proactive steps including the effective launch of a Media Campaign for preventing ragging. Films in ragging are also uploaded on UGC website for use by higher education institutions.

As a step further, UGC has decided that Anti Ragging Day would be observed on 12th August followed by Anti Ragging Week from 12th August to 18th August. This initiative is one of the tools of the Commission in increasing awareness against ragging. It is further desired to adopt the following activities during the celebration of Anti Ragging Day/Week:

Introduction/Orientation programmes on Anti Ragging. 4.

Conduct various competitions such as slogan & essay writing, poster making, and logodesigning on Anti Ragging and distribute certificates/prizes to encourage the 11. students faculty/non-teaching staff to promote Anti Ragging.
